

## **Home Learning**

Perfect Penguins!

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We found a penguin in the fridge and thought maybe it was there because penguins like the cold! We are going to learn about penguins and try to make our penguin feel at home in our school!

**Joint learning** – In class we will be learning about the days of the week. Over the next few weeks, create a diary to cover the days for just one week. Work with your child to help them write at least one sentence for each day (some children may wish to write more). We would like them to make a diary about what they have done with their penguin and where they have been. At the top of each page, there needs to be the day. This could be written by you or your child. With their sentence, help them to spell common words but also encourage them to listen to the sounds they can hear in more complex words (It doesn't matter if these words are spelt wrong but if you could write the word underneath it will help us if they can't read it out in class). We have sent home a book that can be used for the diary but feel free to use something else if you prefer! This diary needs to be brought into school by **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February.**

**Pupil Learning** – To follow the instructions and make a penguin to look after at home. This is the penguin that will feature in your diary.

**Adult learning** – Tell your child about an amazing adventure or journey you have been on. Tell them where you were going and what you saw. Work with your child so they can give a basic talk to the class about what you did! You might want to send in a photograph or an object with your child to help them share your experience.

During this project, our outcome will be a morning session to come and play with your child, conducting a range of phonic activities. These will give you an insight into the phonics that takes place in school and will give you some ideas about phonic activities that you could create at home for your child to enjoy. Our outcome will take place on **Monday 29<sup>th</sup> January. It will start at 9am and finish at 10:15am.**
